

CONFIDENTIALITY AND STUDENT PRIVACY POLICY

It is the policy of the Lionheart Classical Academy (LCA) to respect the privacy, dignity, and confidentiality of all students and employees at LCA. This policy covers employee/personnel records, student records, medical information, and other personally identifiable sources of information. As a classical school committed to truth, virtue, and wisdom, we recognize confidentiality as an essential element of moral responsibility and professional conduct and a legal obligation under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

With that, it is the policy of LCA that such personally identifiable information should only be viewed or received by someone with a legitimate educational interest in viewing or receiving the information, as well as those officials involved in a supervisory capacity over the school in which the students are enrolled.

All LCA employees and Board of Trustees shall comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.

The Organizational Committee and the Executive Director will develop any necessary procedures for the implementation of this policy. Annual notification to parents per FERPA requirements will be completed annually.
